Dear Doctor Adler:

Rabbi Raphael Don Plätzki, perhaps the greatest Talmudic scholar in Poland, is here in behalf of the Mesywta, the Yeshiba in Warsaw of which he is the head.

The hostile relations between Poland and Lithuania made it quite impossible for Polish students to attend as in former years, the great Yeshiba in Lithuania. The establishment of this Yeshiba at Warsaw is of vital need to Polish Jewry but in view of the fact that Poland had up to this very time no yeshiba of importance ~~and~~ the expected support of the Mesywta has not been realized, ~~may~~ of course as ^{one} usual look, for assistance from American Israel.

The Yeshiba is at present attended by about six hundred young men and its budget is accordingly quite a considerable one. If your Committee could be of help to this institution I am sure it would be instrumental in the revival of Jewish learning in Poland.
