



Mrs. Shmuel Chaim Kessler (Yerushalayim) and Reb Leizer Aron Kessler (Brooklyn) identified Reb Avraham Yeshaya (Kislowitz) Kessler, *z"l*, circled in these two photos. "He and his wife, Blanca, married in 1947; she helped him with his work and together they saved 300 boys. He was *niftar* this past year. His wife Blanca (Leah Tzivya bas Chaya, *a"h*) was *niftar* recently; she survived the war, including Auschwitz. After liberation a very wealthy gentile wanted to marry her, but she insisted on marrying a *yeshivah bachur*, as that is what she

remembered from her father.

"She married Reb Avraham Yeshaya, who had learned in Baranovitch. With their strong *emunah* and *bitachon* they built a beautiful generation. They lived in Boro Park. Reb Avraham Yeshaya was sent to Russia during the war; after the war he was in Germany, and Agudas Yisroel sent him to Poland to help out with the boys. They lived in Eretz Yisrael a short while after the war and he later attended a very special *asifah* in Bnei Brak with the 300 boys he saved, together with their families!"
